DIPLOMA OPTIONS

1. Bina – Understanding (48-credit diploma)

Students must complete a minimum of **two credits in each of the subject areas listed below.**

2. Da'at – Knowledge (24-credit diploma)

Students must complete a minimum of **one credit in each of the subject areas listed below.**

Bible	Arts and Culture
Community Service & Leadership	History
Ethics/Thought	Literature
Hebrew	Rabbinics

In addition, students are **required to take the following classes for either diploma:**

- 1 semester of Talmud
- 1 semester of Question in Search of Answer (usually in 11th grade)
- 1 semester of a course on Israel
- 1 semester of Comparative Religions

Individual synagogues may also require their students to take certain classes in order to fulfill confirmation requirements.

In order to receive credit for a course, **a student must attend at least 75% of classes.**

For extra credit, students may earn **a maximum of 1 MIDRASHA credit each year** in each of the following areas:

- Attending a Jewish camp
- Performing community service (regular commitment)
- Tutoring (Bar/Bat Mitzvah, religious school) or Teachers Aide (religious school)
- Traveling to Israel (on an organized trip with significant educational content of at least two weeks in duration)
- Newspaper, radio, tv or film production with Jewish content at the discretion of the Director.

NOTE: It is the responsibility of the student to let us know about involvement in extra credit activities. All transcript requests should be sent to Shari Weinberger by email to: sweinberger@bjeri.org.

Be sure to show your **MIDRASHA** transcript when you apply to any special programs, activities, or even college! Admission directors are very enthusiastic about teens who are involved in programs like **MIDRASHA**.
